The Orchard Foundation is a nonprofit local education fund established as a resource for Central Louisiana that works with school districts, businesses, and communities to improve educational opportunities in a nine-parish service area: Allen, Avoyelles, Catahoula, Grant, LaSalle, Natchitoches, Rapides, Vernon and Winn. The Orchard Foundation's mission is to improve academic achievement for Central Louisiana students by promoting best practices; recruiting, retaining, and rewarding excellent and innovative teachers; building school leadership; and strengthening school and community relationships. The Orchard Foundation's activities as described are carried out for the benefit of its supported organization, The Rapides Foundation.

The Orchard Foundation's mission is to improve academic achievement for Central Louisiana students by promoting best practices; recruiting, retaining, and rewarding excellent and innovative teachers; building school leadership; and strengthening school and community relationships.

The Orchard Foundation's <u>Advanced Leadership Academies</u> continue to support the development of strong instructional leadership throughout the Central Louisiana region by developing and offering training for current school leaders. Advanced Leadership Academies were offered during Spring and Fall of 2008 to all superintendents and select experienced district administrators and principals. They were conducted by a nationally-recognized entity in this expertise area, The Center for Educational Leadership Center at the University of Washington.

The Academies focused on the attributes of effective teaching, including purpose, rigor and engagement. Great emphasis was placed on writing and mathematical skills, which are crucial in preparing children for a future centered on a global economy. A key objective of the sessions was to equip the leaders with the instructional expertise necessary to enable them to effectively develop, coach and mentor the teaching staff at their school or district.

Approximately 145 district office and school administrators attended these monthly training sessions in 2008.

Direct expenses were \$361,782 and there were no grants.

The Orchard Foundation also builds strong instructional leadership throughout the Central Louisiana region by developing and offering Leadership Academies for new and aspiring leaders within the school districts. These academies, New Administrators' Academy and Emerging Leaders' Academy, both serve as hands-on learning tools for prospective school and district leaders. In 2008, approximately 85 educators participated in these monthly courses taught by the Urban Learning and Leadership Center, based in Newport News, Virginia. The sessions explored the concept of distributed leadership and distributed accountability in the schools. Participants also explored the complexity of school cultures made up of a social, academic and moral fabric.

Direct expenses were \$119,712 and there were no grants.

The Wood Works program is a high school course that prepares students for careers in the forest products industry. The course of study includes training in safety, applied math, forestry, employability skills, wood industry terminology, and an introduction to the wood industry. The course was taught in four area high schools during 2008. At the end of the first pilot year, May 2008, 33 students had completed the course, and several were hired by a local wood products company.

Direct expenses were \$71,242 and there were no grants.

In 2008, planning began for a new focus on science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) along with career and technical education (CTE). The Orchard Foundation will continue to focus on the development of K-12 schooling by integrating STEM and CTE into the curriculum.

Direct expenses were \$57,171 and there were no grants.

The Orchard Foundation has adopted and functions under the policies of its supported organization, The Rapides Foundation. The Orchard Foundation has both a "Staff Code of Ethics and Conduct" and a "Trustee Code of Ethics and Conduct," both of which define and describe actions to be taken in the event of conflicts of interest. The "Staff Code of Ethics and Conduct" is monitored and enforced through organizational procedures, controls and daily supervision of employees by the next level of management. The "Trustee Code of Ethics and Conduct" is monitored at each trustee board and committee meeting, as the first agenda item is one in which trustees are asked to disclose any potential conflicts with listed agenda items. A trustee that has a potential conflict of interest with a matter that comes before the board or committee is required to leave the room before the matter is discussed, and a majority vote of the remaining disinterested board trustees determine whether a conflict actually exists. If a conflict is determined to exist, then the conflicted trustee is not allowed to be present during board discussion and vote on the issue creating the conflict. Each year, trustees and key employees are required to complete a conflict of interest questionnaire to disclose business and personal relationships that could be potential conflicts of interests.

Orchard Foundation employees are leased from The Rapides Foundation (TRF) (Supported Organization). TRF Board Compensation Committee, which is composed of the independent members of its Executive Committee, engages a third-party compensation consultant to provide market information concerning pay and benefits and make compensation structure recommendations for all organization positions. The consultant is provided with job descriptions for all job positions. The consultant then compares those jobs with similar positions at similar types and sizes of organizations. The consultant meets with the Compensation Committee and provides the comparison data, along with their recommendations for pay ranges for each position (minimum, midpoint, maximum). Recommendations are based upon market averages of similar types and sizes of organizations.

The CEO and two directors of the organization are considered key employees. The CEO recommends the pay for the two directors and a salary budget for the remaining employees to the

Compensation Committee for approval. The consultant meets with the Compensation Committee independently to discuss recommendations for CEO pay.
